

Indian Grass (Sorghastrum nutans)

Technical Sheet

A very decorative warm season bunch grass that produces soft golden seed heads. It makes for a great partner for a wide range of prairie flowers. Plant along with Little Bluestem for a wonderful color combination in the fall. Grows on any well drained soil, from dry sand to heavy clay.

Good for erosion control, landscaping, and roadside beautification.

Provides an excellent grass for wildlife habitat and nesting cover.
