

Snow / Safety Fence

Technical Sheet

Installation suggestions,

1. Two end posts should be driven into the ground to a depth of 18-24 inches. For permanent installations, wood posts set into cement are recommended. Guy wires may be needed with end posts to tension fence.
2. Posts should be spaced every 8-10 feet. (For snow fence, place posts at 6-8 feet intervals.) To secure fencing, wrap cable ties around fence strand and post at three points along height of each rod or post. Tension rope may be needed to prevent potential sagging.
3. Two sections of fence may be connected by overlapping the ends 8-10 inches and joining with cable ties or weaving a rod through both fences.
4. For installations exposed to heavy winds, fence should be sandwiched in between posts and wood lath strips.
