

Slender Wheatgrass (*Elymus trachycaulus*)

Technical Sheet

A rapid establisher, cool season, tufted bunch grass. It grows quickly to hold the soil then fades back in the first few years to give other grasses a chance to become established.

Used to revegetate disturbed lands and can tolerate long wet periods.

Actively grows during the spring and fall when soil temperatures are cooler.

Provides good wildlife cover due to its upright structure and standing residue. Is palatable and nutritious for livestock but cannot withstand continuous grazing. It does produce a good quality hay.
