

Timothy

Technical Sheet

Timothy is a bunch grass which can grow up to 5 feet tall with a root depth of 10 inches especially if it is fertilized.

Makes an excellent horse pasture either as a portion of a mixture or strictly by itself. Digestion systems of livestock will remain normal as they graze on Timothy.

Timothy hay is rich in long fiber and its abrasive texture helps to grind down the teeth, keeping both the teeth and jaw in good order.

Tolerances for shade are moderate, low for drought and low for salt.

Keep in mind that timothy is shallow-rooted and thus should not be considered the primary species for erosion control plantings.

Timothy can be found growing in waterways, dry to wet meadows and other mesic environments. It is not well adapted to wet, flat land where water stands for extended periods of time, though it can withstand somewhat poorly-drained soils.

Timothy is very winter-hardy. It exhibits tolerance to both cold temperature, and ice encasement, a major factor affecting winter survival.
